Resignation – Brandon Breault resigned effective September 18, 2017.

Turnpike Road – On Saturday, September 23rd, in the area of the TFHS football field, a sixteen inch valve was replaced. The job took 10 hours and cost approximately \$10,000.00. Bruce mentioned he stopped by a few times and commended Mike, Jeff and Steve for all the work they did, especially being down a man.

General Pierce Bridge – Not further information as things have been busy being short an operator.

Forestry – A four thousand dollar check was received this week. All is going well and they still have next spring and summer.

Lead and Copper – Letters being sent this week to residents who provided samples. No homes were over or near the limit.

Meter Reading – Jeff and Steve began reading Monday.

Southworth/Paperlogic – They have filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy. Their outstanding balance with us is over \$24,899.60 with current bills being mailed November 1st. Mike received permission from the commissioners to turn water off due to non-payment. Sprinkler would be kept active.

Clerk/Collector – Presented residential backflow billing, signed by commissioners. Billing and collection comparisons shared.

Dave and Allyson left at this time.

Executive Session—went into executive session at 5:25p.m. to review and discuss applications for water operator position. It was decided to interview 3 candidates on October 11th.
